

Trounson Kauri Park Loop Track, Kauri Coast

A sanctuary in a sea of farmland, Trounson Kauri Park offers some of Northland's most impressive kauri. Almost entirely boardwalked, the 1.7km loop track is a safe way to observe the kauri. A weta box is a great addition to the walk, and the likelihood of spotting North Island brown kiwi at night is high.


